The teacher (part time) jointly oversees the academic, social and emotional development, learning and wellbeing of a very pleasant and well mannered student with developmental delay in some areas, in a caring and supportive environment.

The bulk of the time will be spent directly supporting the learner with dialogue, encouragement, instruction and support. Where time is available due to the learner's engagement in other activities, the teacher will use that time to complete planning and reflecting, and other work related to communication and administration. When more significant non-contact time is required for long term planning, this may be requested via the principal.
